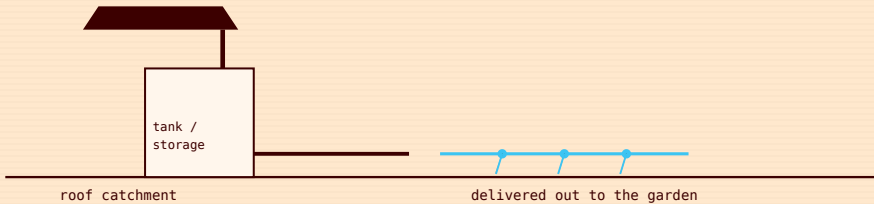

01 Settle, treat, then disperse

A septic system works in stages: solids settle in a tank, partially treated effluent then disperses (via a trench, bed, or more advanced treatment system) into the soil, where natural processes complete the treatment.



02 What you'll need

- A system design appropriately sized for your household and approved by local council/health authority
- Professional installation — septic systems are a regulated, specialist installation in every Australian jurisdiction
- Regular pump-out service access
- Appropriate household practices (what not to flush) to protect the system

03 Method

1. Engage a suitably licensed designer/installer and obtain council/health authority approval before installation — this is a regulated system, not a DIY project.
2. Size the system correctly for your household occupancy and site conditions (soil type, slope, water table).
3. Install with appropriate access for pump-out servicing.
4. Establish household practices that protect the system — avoiding excessive chemicals, fats, and non-biodegradable items down the drain.
5. Schedule regular pump-outs per your system's requirements, typically every few years depending on usage and tank size.

04 Troubleshooting

- **System backing up or slow draining** — often overdue for a pump-out, or a blockage; don't ignore early warning signs.
- **Odour issues** — can indicate a system problem or overdue maintenance; investigate promptly rather than masking the smell.
- **Effluent surfacing in the disposal area** — a sign of system failure or undersizing; requires professional assessment, as it's both a health and environmental issue.
- **Uncertain about approval requirements** — contact your local council directly, as septic system regulations are enforced at the local government level in most of Australia.

05 Timing & maintenance

BEST TIME	Any time, though installation is a professional job regardless of season.
DURATION	A well-maintained system serves a household for decades, with tanks pumped out periodically.
MAINTENANCE	Regular pump-outs (check your system's specific requirements) and mindful household practices protecting the system long-term.
SIGNS OF SUCCESS	No backing up, odour, or surfacing effluent, and pump-outs occurring on the recommended schedule.
